MARCH MEETING MINUTES

March 2, 2010



Call to Order:

- The meeting was called to order by the President, R.Hart, at the Dunn Community Center at 8:06pm.

Approval of Minutes (Christofaro):

- Provided copies of February's minutes for review & approval. Last meeting's attendance was 60 while February's meeting was 19.
- Motion to approve by S.Hoffman, seconded by N.Millian, and motion approved.

Welcome to All (Hart):

- Changes for 2010 – Added Mt. Penn & Lower Alsace townships, softball concession stand is now full service, purchased two new scoreboards for Founder's & Memorial Fields via renewal of Coke contract for next seven years, and introduced the Board Members.

Treasurer's Report (Michalak):

- Presented February's financial report: income of \$10,026 mostly from registration & sponsorships with expenses of \$12,224 via insurance, charter fees, scoreboards, land loan, etc. for a net loss of \$8,198. Motion to approve by J.Paige, seconded by T.Blank, and motion approved.
- Budget is needed as six of our nine fields are owned by E.T.L.L., and it is our cost to maintain them.
- All raffle tickets must be mailed back by April 2nd.
- Motion passed to go with Gianni's Pizza versus Joe Corbi's. Each coach is responsible to fill out the form whether participating or doing a buy-out. Letter and forms will be distributed to coaches at Team Handouts. It must be returned by May 4th meeting. Pick-up is on May 15th (Picture Day). Two hours of volunteer time per team is needed.

Player Agents' Report (Pochron & Napkora):

- Discussed scheduling of games and rainouts. In addition, Boyertown will be fielding a 10U & 12U team and would like to join the E.T.L.L. schedule with both home & away games. This is to be voted upon at the Board Meeting.
- Added an additional interleague game for Majors for two and twelve games will be within E.T.L.L.
- Majors, AAA, and AA teams will not play on Sunday's which is when T-ball & A levels will play.
- A bi-weekly schedule to communicate field availability for make-up games during the season is in progress. Upon receiving the information from the Player Rep, the Secretary will issue this to all Player Reps and the general board.
- An updated Map Complex of all the fields is needed. P.Christofaro has agreed to put this together to be reviewed and then posted on our site.

Field Maintenance Report (Davidheiser):

- Noel and Paul agreed to work together to post the mower deck for sale in March.
- Stone grade for the shed next to the concession stand is to be laid, and the Senior Field is to be excavated for drains.
- Noel & D.Hart wrote a report on how our fields were created & now maintained. We were awarded with the "Field of Distinction" honor from the Keystone Athletic Field Managers Organization (KAFMO).
- Spring Clean-up still on for Saturday, March 13th. Stay tuned to website for the latest. This includes practice and equipment handouts for A, T-ball, & Softball.

Vice President's Report (B.Koch):

- No issues to report with the Stonersville Fire Company. We will be adding a sign below the Little League sign. They have also agreed to participate on both days for Opening Ceremonies.
 - Absolutely no parking is allowed in their parking lot.
- Practice schedules are complete, except approval for our field usage requests to Exeter's A.D. for practice fields, and final number of teams at all levels. Any changes can be worked out amongst teams at your level or through reps. We plan to put a porta-potty at Crestwood, but none at school fields. Remember, no practices allowed starting before 6pm during the week, and lighting of the Hall of Fame field for practices is prohibited.
- School fields need to be kept clean! Schools have first rights to the fields, and we must yield to those activities. If Trout Run complex is locked, please call the township police as no member has a key.
- Zero Tolerance Policy: Alcohol, Drugs, and Pets are prohibited within the complex along with any behavior not tolerable to a Little League game. Tobacco and cell phones are not permitted in the dugouts and on the fields.
- We are still aggressively pursuing lights on the middle-upper field for softball. Current estimates are from \$60k to \$80k. We are investigating financing options.

Softball Report (McDevitt):

- Nothing new to report. All is set for Softball Tryouts!

President's Report (Hart):

- 2010 Teams:
 - Baseball: Majors = 7, AAA = 6, AA = 8, A = 12, and T-ball = 14
 - Softball: 14U = 1, 12U = 5, 10U = 4, and 8U = 5.
 - Senior League = 3 teams
- Coaches Clinics were awesome! Nice job to Millian and McDevitt.
- Tryouts/evaluations at Grand Slam Sports Complex have been revised to 4-9pm. Evaluators needed.
- Six indoor evenings will be held this year for baseball. Three sessions for each level of 9's, 10's, 11's, and 12's. Schedule to be handed out at Tryouts and posted on-line.
- Fall Ball signups will begin at Opening Day ceremonies.
- Sponsors are still needed for teams. Information can be found on the website.
- Team Mom meeting is scheduled for Saturday, April 3rd in the morning.
- For Rainouts or closing of the complex, targeting a message on the voice mail (610-689-9847) at 2pm, a posting on the website (www.exeterlittleleague.org) by 4pm, and a sign on the gate by 5pm.
- For any and all parent / player issues, PLEASE discuss this with your Player Rep. If the rep cannot resolve, he will then contact the Board members as needed.

Old Business:

- Exeter's "Coaches Handbook" has been "published" for baseball. It is being finalized for softball.
- T & A-fields need to be dressed. Bids being received to top dress and seed in the fall.
- A lightning detection system has been purchased and will be installed in the main concession stand. Notification for taking shelter will be made via a single blast from an air horn. The other concession stand will then signal via a single also. Once 30 minutes has passed from the last bolt of lightning or clap of thunder, two blasts will be used to signal that all is clear.
